

Event attendees: Preparation and requirements for CATTLE / BUFFALO

Property Identification Code: PIC

- All owners of cattle must have a valid PIC for where their stock are kept.

Identification:

- All cattle must be tagged with
 - an NLIS device
 - in the animal's right ear
 - the device may be orange or white
- the NLIS device must be registered to the owner's PIC on the NLIS database
- All cattle must be earmarked and/or branded.

ID Exemptions: Approved identification systems are in place –

- **Dexter** cattle belonging to members of the **Dexter Group of WA** may travel with only an NLIS device.
- **Murray Grey** cattle registered to the **Murray Grey Beef Cattle Society of Western Australia** may travel with Murray Grey Breed Society ear tattoo and an NLIS device.
- **Angus** cattle registered to the
 - **Angus Society of Australia** may travel with an NLIS device and either an ear tattoo or approved brand.

Stock moving with Approved ID as above must have the **ID type and society member who identified the animal** written on the waybill. eg:
Monterey Stud tattoo

Movement:

- All cattle leaving the property must travel with a complete waybill.
 - It is acceptable to use the one waybill that reads "destination to XX Showground and return" so that only one waybill is needed.
 - Provide the original waybill to the event manager / livestock steward.
- Cattle should be 'sighted' on the NLIS database at the event site as arranged by the event managers / livestock steward.
- Any cattle leaving the showgrounds that will not be returning to the home property need to have a new waybill written for the movement off the showgrounds to the next location. This is the cattle owner's responsibility.
