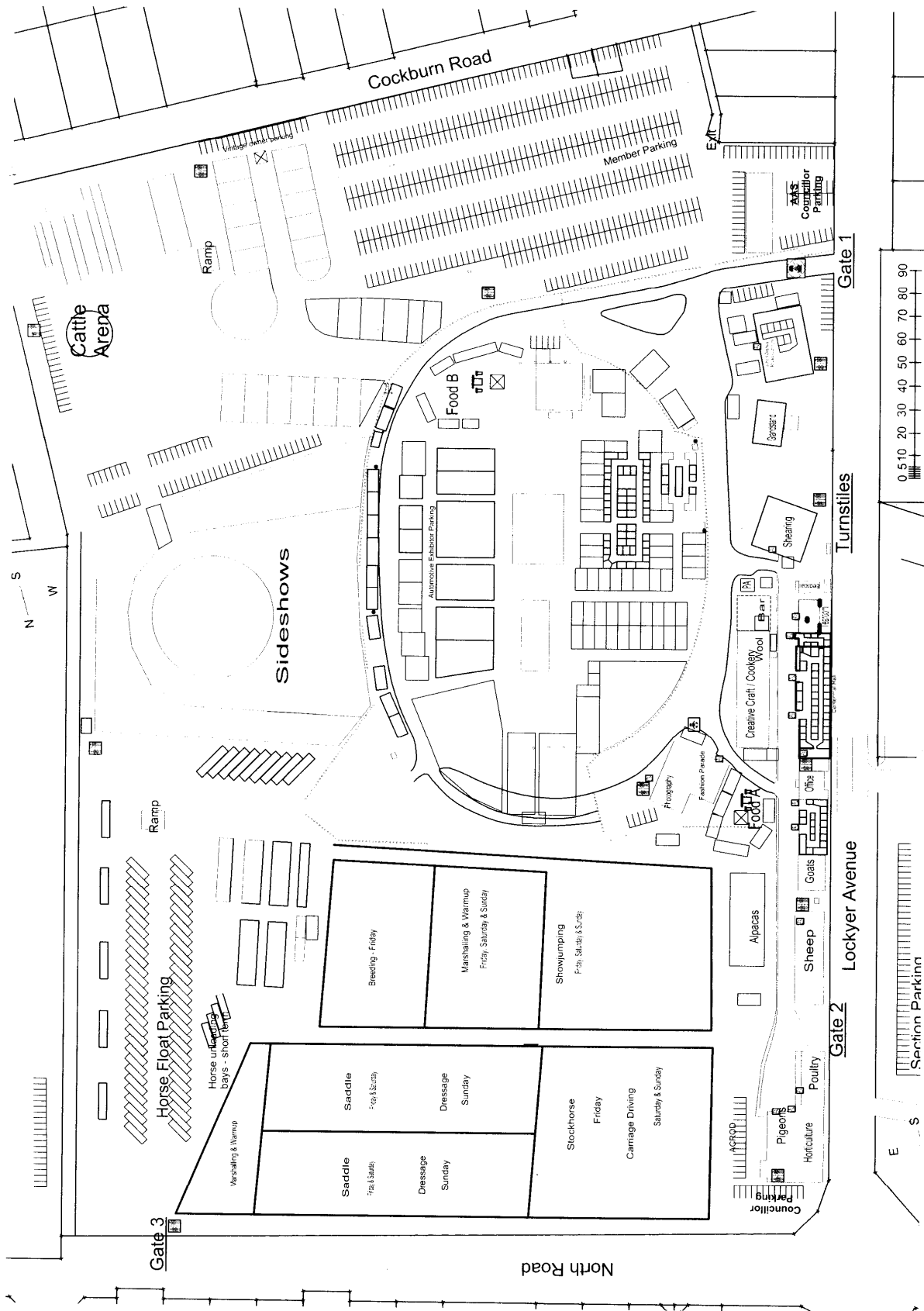

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Society's Annual Show is held under the Society's Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be seen at the Secretary's office. The committee may add, alter, vary or revoke any Rules and Regulations it may deem advisable.
2. The committee reserves the power to reject or remove any Exhibitor, servant or attendant, or any visitor from the Show without being required to give any explanation or being liable for compensation. The powers conferred on the committee shall be delegated to the Secretary and all monies won by such offenders shall be forfeited.
3. **NO DOGS**, except for exhibition, will be allowed on the grounds. 
4. The committee reserves the right to postpone, and further postpone any Show from the advertised date, and may make any alterations it deems desirable in the schedule of prizes, or other show arrangements.
5. The decision of the Society on all points shall be final and without recourse.
6. No exhibit shall be staged for competition until subscription or entrance fees are paid to the Society.
7. **NO GATE ENTRY FEE WILL BE REFUNDED.**
8. Quantities, weights and numbers will be strictly adhered to.
9. Membership fees: Family Up to two Adults and children under 16 YO) \$45; Adult \$20; Senior (Aged and Senior Card holder) \$15; Senior over 80 years of age FREE; Young Adult (16 & 17 YO) \$15; Junior (6 – 15 YO inclusive) \$10; Infant (0 - 5 YO inclusive) FREE, First Parking Pass \$4; Second Parking Pass \$10.
10. All persons competing and exhibiting in the Show do so at their own risk.
11. No protest will be considered if person protesting has not an entry in the class concerned.
12. The Head steward of each section reserves the right to reject and remove from the ground any exhibit, which is in their opinion dangerous or objectionable.
13. The Albany Agricultural Society Incorporated Committee will not be held liable for loss of or damage to the exhibitor's property whilst on the grounds.
14. Stewards reserve the right to re-enter an entry into a more appropriate section and/or class.
15. Please ensure all vehicles are removed immediately after they have been unloaded and parked opposite the Showground in Lockyer Ave. All vehicles parked illegally upon the grounds shall be **TOWED AWAY WITHOUT NOTICE.** 
16. **NO ALCOHOL** is to be brought onto the grounds.

All exhibitors must pay entrance fee to the grounds each day unless financial members of the Albany Agricultural Society Inc.

Exhibitors will please check individual sections for times that exhibits in the various sections must be in place. These times will be rigidly adhered to.

Exhibits MUST NOT be dismantled or removed from ground before 5:00pm Saturday.

In the event of there being no competition in any particular Class, prizes may be given if the judges certify to particular merit, however, they are specifically requested to with-hold prizes - even where there is competition if the exhibits are of inferior description, or not suitable for the class in which they are competing, they may be awarded a 2nd prize.

Prize money where applicable will be available at the Secretary's office from 1:00pm Saturday 12th November 2011. If you are GST registered, you must provide a tax invoice to the Albany Agricultural Society to claim prize money including GST. All prize money not collected by Friday 16th December 2011 (or tax invoices not lodged) will revert back to the Society.

Entries in Trade Display Sections and various Show Sections will be received by the Society's office at the Showground, **please check your relevant section for closing dates AS NO LATE ENTRIES ARE RECEIVED IN MOST SECTIONS.**

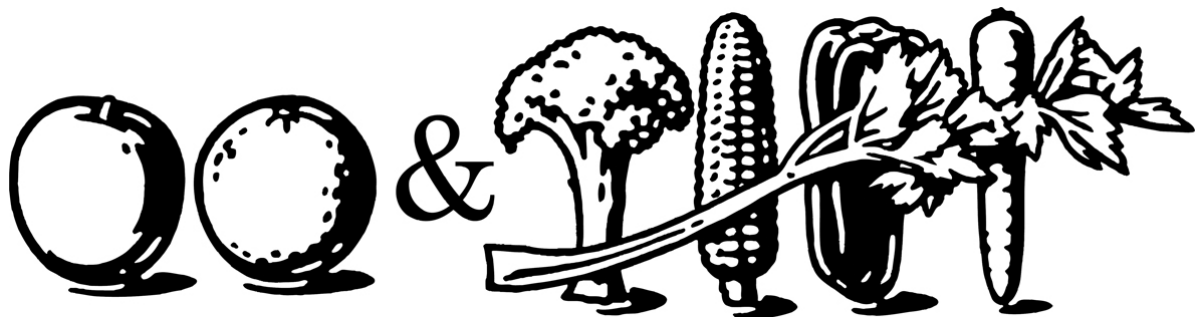
- ◆ **Parking** - Vehicles and Floats may be parked on the Showground in an orderly manner and as directed by Parking Attendants. Trucks to park as Directed and are asked not to block the entrance to any horse and pedestrian areas.
- ◆ **Gate Fees** - are to be to be paid by all non-members prior to entry to the Showground.
- ◆ **Security Fencing** along boundary - DO NOT tie up horses to this.
- ◆ **Regulations and Bylaws:** The Society's Annual Show is held under the Society's Rules and Regulations, a copy of which is available at the Secretary's office. The council may add to, alter vary or revoke any rules and regulations as it may deem advisable.
- ◆ **Society's liability:** The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through or by any exhibitor, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Society blameless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any such incident.
- ◆ **Protests:** Must be lodged within half an hour after the event with a deposit of \$50 to a Councillor for the horse section or the Secretary, which shall be forfeited to the society if the protest on due consideration be deemed unfounded or frivolous.
- ◆ **Dangerous or diseased exhibits:** Should the Council have any reason to suspect that any exhibit is dangerous or diseased, it may have the same removed from or refused admission to, the grounds.
- ◆ **Programme:** The Committee reserves the right to alter or amend this program in any way it sees fit without giving prior warning. Classes may be combined or split at the committee/judges discretion. All rings will be running concurrently so competitors are advised to bear this in mind when submitting entries. **CLASSES WILL NOT BE HELD UP FOR A COMPETITOR COMPETING IN ANOTHER RING.**
- ◆ **Refunds:** Non-participation in an event will NOT warrant a refund or entry monies. Entry monies will only be refunded less 20% administration fee if the request is accompanied by a certificate from a Veterinarian or a Doctors Certificate dated within 14 days prior to the show.
- ◆ **Judges:** The Judge's decision in all classes is final. Judges are NOT to be approached under any circumstances by any competitor or spectator. Classes will NOT be held up for late arrivals except at the discretion of the judge.
- ◆ **Entries:** All exhibits **MUST BE ENTERED** under the registered name and in the name of the registered owner or lessee. **HEIGHT/BREED REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES / PAPERS** must be available on the day if required. All Breed classes will be run according to the rules and regulations of the respective Breed Societies and copies of Registration

Papers must be available for sighting if requested by the Chief Steward.

- ◆ **Late Entries:** Entries received after Friday 4th November 2011 will only be accepted at the Agricultural Society Office at the discretion of the Section Organizer together with a Late Penalty fee of \$10.00.
- ◆ **All Colts/Stallions** must be shown in suitable and substantial headgear and **MUST NOT BE HANDLED / RIDDEN BY ANY PERSON UNDER 16 YEARS** unless **PERMITTED BY THEIR BREED SOCIETY**. There will be no substitution of horses from those specified on the entry form. Horse's ages are calculated from the 1st August each year.
- ◆ **Stabling:** A limited number of covered stables will be available. All requests for stables must be lodged on the entry form. Local Horses (within 45kms of Post Office) will be accommodated only if enough room and on a first come (lodgment of entry form) first served basis. All stables are to be left clean or a \$20 fine per stable will apply. Stables can be cleaned for a fee enquires to be made to the ring caravan. All queries regarding stable allocation to Janet Porter 9844 8888.
- ◆ **Armbands & Height Certificates:** Showhorse competitors will be required to produce height certificates to collect armbands. A \$2 refundable deposit per number is to be paid on collection at the Ring Caravan. Numbers are not required for Lead Rein and First Ridden Events.
- ◆ **EWA Disclaimer:** All competitors/riders/exhibitors in the horse section **MUST** complete the Equestrian Federation Disclaimer Form before bringing horses onto the showground.
Please ensure this is completed and returned with your entry form.
- ◆ **Eligibility** – Competitors must be members of EWA or Albany Agricultural Society to be eligible to compete.
- ◆ **Ground Fee** - a ground fee of \$2.00 per horse per day is payable by all competitors.
- ◆ **Entry to Grounds** – Please enter the Showgrounds through the North Road entrance unless arriving between 6:00pm Thursday and 6:00am Friday in which case you will enter through Gate 1 Lockyer Avenue.
