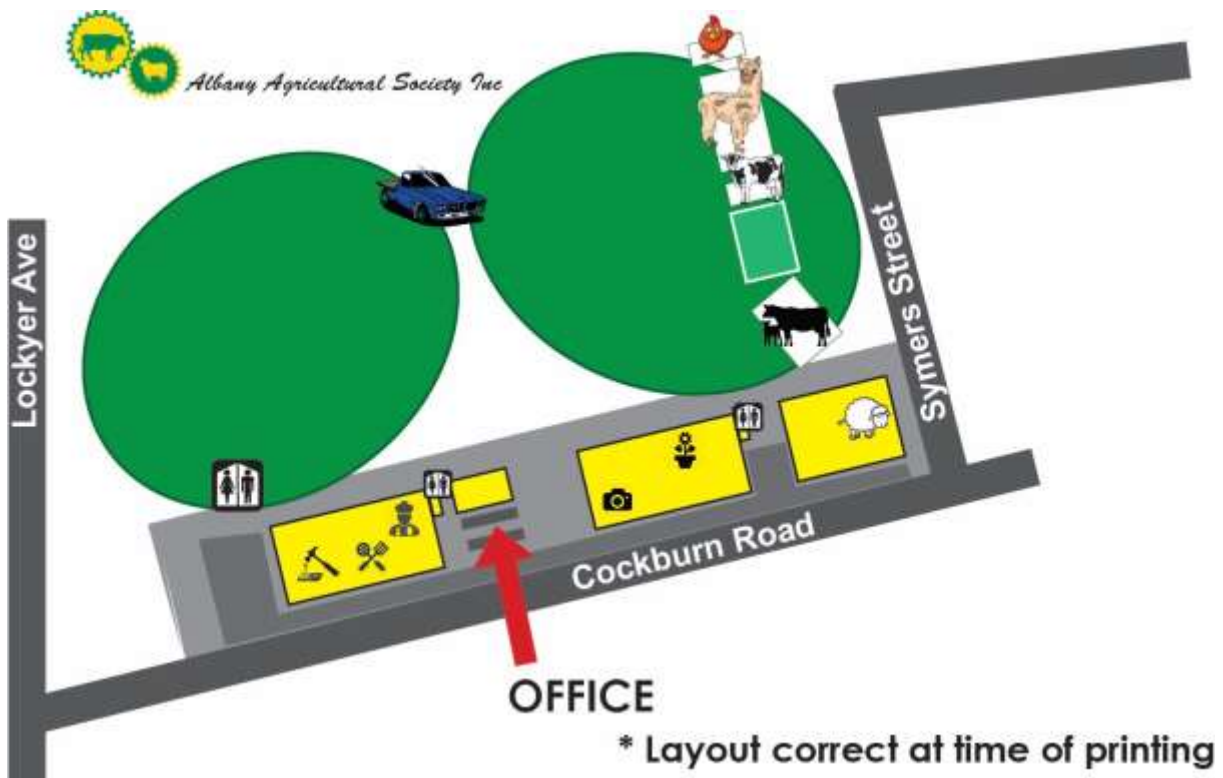
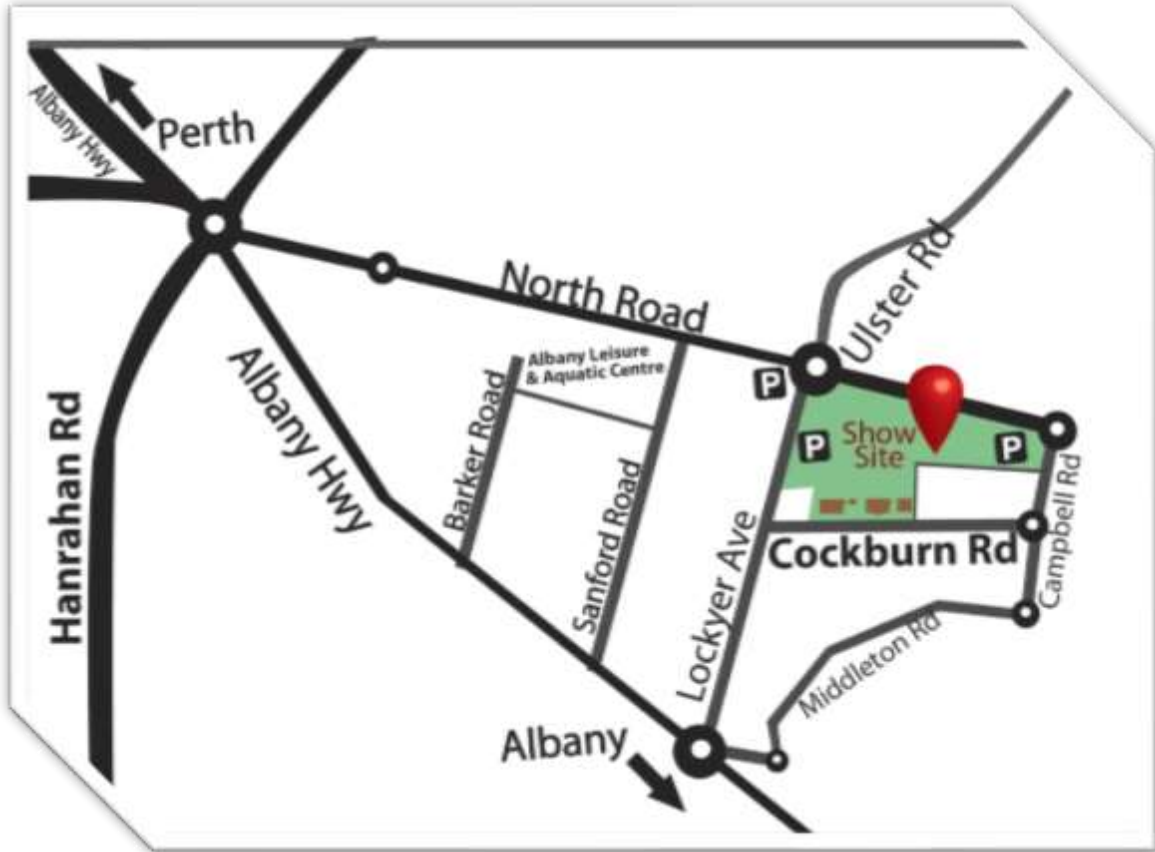

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Society's Annual Show is held under the Society's Rules and Regulations. The committee may add, alter, vary or revoke any Rules and Regulations it may deem advisable.
2. No exhibit shall be staged for competition until subscription or entrance fees are paid to the Society. Fees may be paid by direct credit, cheque, EFTPOS or cash. Entry Forms may be received via email, or mail. If Entry Cards are to be returned please allow time for them to be processed.
3. The committee reserves the power to reject or remove any Exhibitor, servant or attendant, or any visitor from the Show without being required to give any explanation or being liable for compensation. The powers conferred on the committee shall be delegated to the Secretary and all monies won by such offenders shall be forfeited.
4. **NO DOGS**, excepting registered Assistance Dogs or Dogs for exhibition/competition, will be allowed on the grounds. 
5. The committee reserves the right to postpone, and further postpone any Show from the advertised date, and may make any alterations it deems desirable in the schedule of prizes, or other show arrangements.
6. The decision of the Society on all points shall be final and without recourse.
7. **NO GATE ENTRY FEE AND/OR MEMBERSHIP FEES WILL BE REFUNDED.**
8. Quantities, weights and numbers will be strictly adhered to.
9. All persons competing and exhibiting in the Show do so at their own risk.
10. No protest will be considered if person protesting has not an entry in the class concerned.
11. The Head Steward of each section reserves the right to reject and remove from the ground any exhibit, which is in their opinion dangerous or objectionable.
12. The Albany Agricultural Society Incorporated Committee will not be held liable for loss of or damage to the exhibitor's property whilst on the grounds.
13. Stewards reserve the right to re-enter an entry into a more appropriate section and/or class.
14. Please ensure all vehicles are removed immediately after they have been unloaded and parked offsite in public parking zones. All vehicles parked illegally upon the grounds shall be **TOWED AWAY WITHOUT NOTICE.**
15. **NO ALCOHOL** is to be brought onto the grounds.

NOTICES

All exhibitors must pay entrance fee to the grounds on Show Days.

Exhibitors will please check individual sections for times that exhibits in the various sections must be in place. These times will be rigidly adhered to.

Exhibits MUST NOT be dismantled or removed from the ground before 5:00pm on Saturday.

In the event of there being no competition in any particular Class, prizes may be given if the judges certify to particular merit, however, they are specifically requested to with-hold prizes - even where there is competition if the exhibits are of inferior description, or not suitable for the class in which they are competing, they may be awarded a 2nd prize.

Prize money where applicable will be available at the Secretary's office from 2:00pm Saturday 10th November 2018. If you are GST registered, you must provide a tax invoice to the Albany Agricultural Society to claim prize money including GST. All prize money not collected by **Wednesday 21st November 2018** (or tax invoices not lodged) will revert back to the Society.

Entries in Show Sections will be received by the Society's office. New location: 88 Cockburn Road.

Please check your relevant section for closing dates AS NO LATE ENTRIES ARE RECEIVED.

The Committee reserves the right to restrict entries in any class should the need arise. Please submit all entries on the original application forms supplied with the Schedule for that section. For the Alpacas section, this is a **requirement**. All forms for that section **MUST** be completed.

SECTION 2PH – PHOTOGRAPHY

RULES OF ENTRY:

1. Photographs **MUST** be taken by, but not necessarily processed, by the exhibitor. Any modification of the image must be done by the exhibitor or under their personal direction.
2. Limit of 3 entries per class per exhibitor.
3. Any one image may be entered in one class only and derivatives of that image may not be submitted as separate images in other classes.
4. Entries exhibited at previous Albany Agricultural Shows are not permitted.
5. Prizes to be awarded on the Judge's decision. Prizes are not necessarily awarded.
6. Failure to comply with the rules of entry and presentation will result in non-acceptance.
7. All accepted entries will be submitted for judging but all may not be displayed if insufficient space available.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MOUNTING OF PRINT ENTRIES:

Snapshots – must be card mounted.

Enlargements – all prints over 15 x 10cm must be card mounted with **HARD CARD** backing, (not chipboard or ply) May be block mounted.

All prints must be mounted singularly.

Correct part of Exhibitors Ticket must be taped to the **centre** of bottom edge of mount.

On the **reverse** side must be your **name and address, subject title, class and section** and to be marked to indicate top when viewed correctly.

No hangers, tapes or velcro to be attached to the mount please.

No title or name to be written on the front of entry.

Examples of mounting will be on display in Agricultural Society Office. If in doubt please check.

SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES:

1. Entry forms and payment must be left at the Agricultural Society Office at 88 Cockburn Road, Albany by Friday **2nd November 2018**.

Entry forms available at the office or on line from (www.albanyshow.org.au) or (www.albanyphotographicsociety.com) and **note that exhibition tickets must be collected from Show office prior to 4:00pm Wednesday 7th November 2018 and attached as per above.**

2. Entries with BLUE EXHIBITORS CARD ATTACHED must be benched on **Wednesday 7th November 2018** between **4:00pm and 6:00pm** in the Exhibition Pavilion at 88 Cockburn Road, Albany 6330

ENTRIES CAN NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER 6:00PM. Entries may be lodged at Show Office prior to 4:00pm on Wednesday 7th November 2018.

The portion of entry card returned to the exhibitor should be retained for presentation on collection of entries.

3. Removal (only by stewards) between **5:00pm – 5:30pm on Saturday 10th November 2018.**
THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTION TO THIS RULE.

Stewards must sight entrant's portion of exhibitor's card. Entries and prize money or vouchers not collected at this time will be held at the Agricultural Society Office until 21st November 2018.

DEFINITION OF SUBJECTS:

OPEN - any subject treated pictorially. Images for the OPEN category **should not be of subjects that could have been entered in another category;** for instance – the subject should not be a landscape, portrait or one of the nature categories. Examples of suitable subjects are Architecture, Abstracts, Events.

LANDSCAPE - picture of natural scenery which may include trees, people, houses or other objects, provided that these elements do not dominate the picture.

SEASCAPE - a picture of natural coastal scenery, a wave study or picture of the open sea, boats and other items of marine interest may be included as incidental items.

WILD FLOWER STUDY – must be of native Australian species photographed insitu whether in garden or bush. May be single or multiple blooms.

CULTIVATED FLOWER STUDY – Image of flower/s of non-native species. Container may form part of picture of living flowers.

ACTION – subject must be in motion

PORTRAIT (1-3 persons) - head to full length portrait which may be an environmental portrait or include accessories.

ANIMAL (including REPTILE) - part or whole, domestic or wild.

BIRD - part or whole, domestic or wild.

INSECT - part or whole.

MONOCHROME - (Enlargements) may be black & white or an image containing shades of any one colour. If toning is carried out it must be over the total print. Partial toning or the addition of one extra colour is not acceptable in the Monochrome section.
